LIMIT) ORDER 201[-]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- 1) prohibit the driving of vehicles at a speed exceeding 30 mph in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
- 2) prohibit the driving of vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 mph in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice; and
- 3) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads, Hambrook) (Restricted Roads) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice. This will be brought forward into the new order subject to the provisions of item 2) above.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at Patchway One Stop Shop, The Patchway Hub, Rodway Road, Patchway and at Kingswood One Stop Shop, The Council Offices, Civic Centre, High Street, Kingswood during normal office hours and at Bradley Stoke Public Library, Fiddlers Wood Road, Bradley Stoke; at Filton Library, Link Road, Filton; at The Library, Emerson Way, Emersons Green, BS16 7AP and at Winterbourne Public Library, Flax Pits Lane, Winterbourne, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours. SCHEDULE 1

Proposed 30 mph Speed Limit (currently unrestricted unless otherwise stated)

HAMBROOK LANE

- from 32m south west of Curtis Lane south eastwards to 89m south east of the south easternmost kerblines of Stoke Gifford Transport Link, a distance of approx. 199m
(currently 40 mph speed limit)

STOKE GIFFORD TRANSPORT LINK

- from the northernmost kerblines of the A4174 Avon Ring Road north eastwards to 55m north east of Hambrook Lane, a distance of approx. 981m

SCHEDULE 2

Proposed 40 mph Speed Limit (currently unrestricted unless otherwise stated)

STOKE GIFFORD TRANSPORT LINK

- from the southernmost kerblines of the Parkway North roundabout southwards to 55m north of Hambrook Lane, a distance of approx. 587m

SCHEDULE 3

HAMBROOK LANE

- from 270m west of the B4427 Old Gloucester Road to 32m south west of Curtis Lane, a distance of approx.. 730m
