Subject: South Gloucestershire Policies, Sites and Places Plan: INVITATION TO LOCAL GREEN SPACES MEETING

Dear Clerk,

The purpose of this email is to invite representatives of your Parish/Town Council to attend a meeting to discuss the list of nominated Local Green Spaces for inclusion in the Policies, Sites and Places Plan (PSP Plan) in your area.

The Proposed Submission PSP Plan includes Policy PSP4: Designated Local Green Spaces. This policy restricts inappropriate development on land designated as a Local Green Space (LGS). LGS are green areas of particular importance to local communities, and these will be identified in Appendix 2 of the Plan and on the Policies Map. This policy can be accessed from the following link: www.southglos.gov.uk/PSPpublication

The list of nominated Local Green Spaces will be subject to further informal consultation, which is anticipated to commence in mid June 2015, for a period of 6 weeks.

During the preparation of the PSP Plan we have engaged with our communities, including Town and Parish Councils and requested that they provide details of potential spaces for Local Green Space designation. We are now inviting representatives of your Parish/Town Council to attend a meeting, with officers from the Strategic Planning Policy and Specialist Advice Team, in order to ensure that all proposed LGS are:

- consistent with national and local policy;
- are supported by appropriate justification for each space; and
- have been mapped accurately.

This is necessary in order that spaces suitable to designation can be recommended to the Council for inclusion in the PSP Plan. A further formal period of public consultation on the final list of spaces will follow later in the year. We therefore strongly encourage your Parish/Town Council representatives to attend one of the meetings shown below, as this will assist your council in responding to the informal consultation.

Please note this is not an invitation to submit further spaces for LGS designation.

The meeting will take the form of a presentation to all those attending, followed by individual Parish/Town Council surgeries with officers available to discuss the LGS which have been nominated for your specific area and review the consultation material. Up to 4 representatives of your council would be welcome to attend a session. If you would also like your local Ward Member to attend please liaise directly with them.

The following meeting sessions have been arranged. Please note that although 2 hourly sessions have been arranged in many instances it is likely that the sessions will be completed in a much shorter time.
