This pond is well hidden behind a thick hedge and plenty of nettles and brambles and is quite undisturbed.

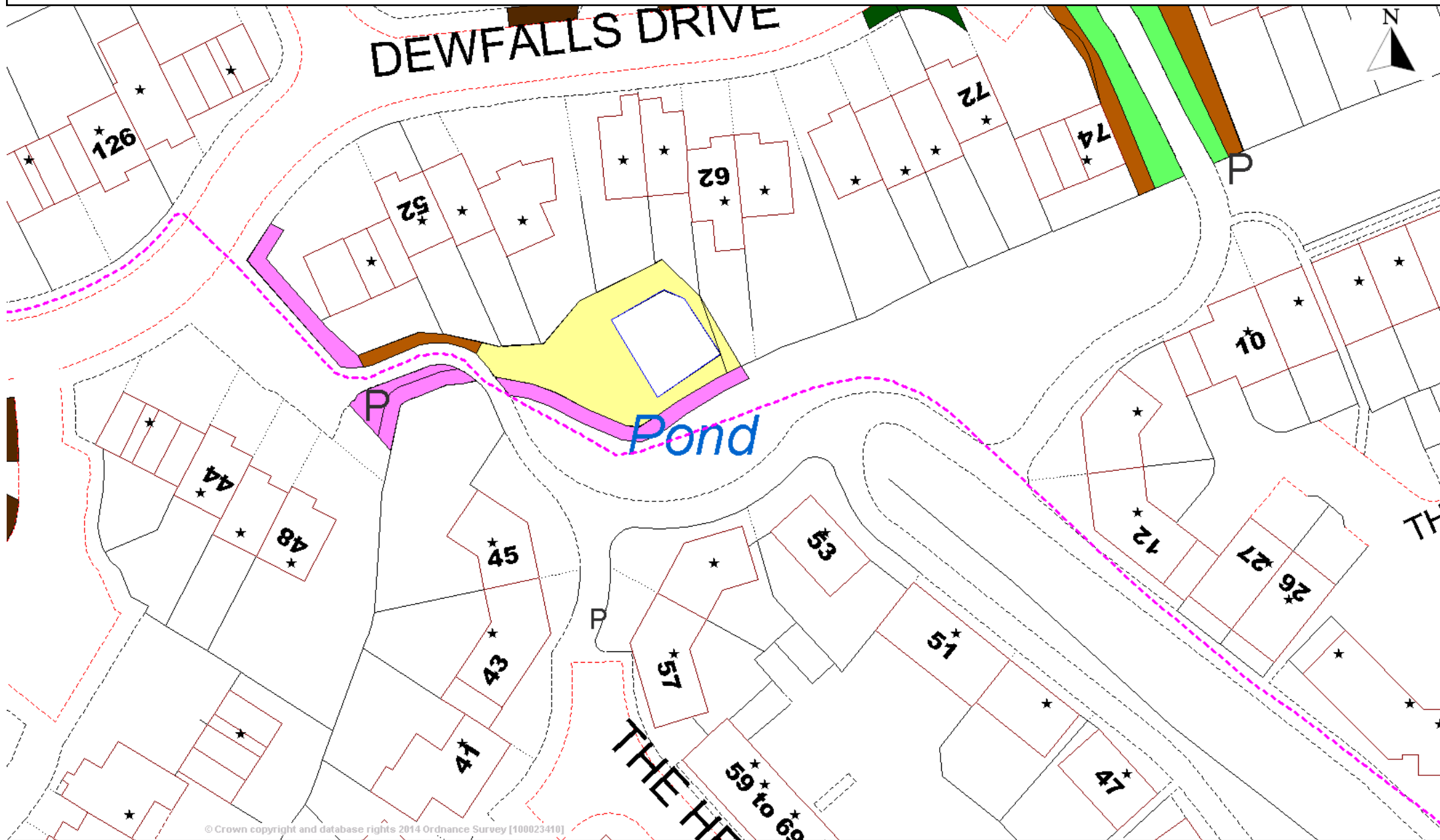
