Re your follow-up letter dated 25th November 2015, I confirm that I do own part of the land in the proposed LGS, code LGSD534, land associated with the historic complex of buildings at Olveston Court.

For your information I've shaded the area which I own in red on the attached plan.

I didn't respond to the earlier invitation to comment because, whilst I would resist greater restrictions placed on my use of the land, given that it is within a conservation area and near to (although not part of) buildings of historic interest it seemed to me that it's designation as an LGS will make very little difference to it's future use.

My land (a paddock and a smaller paddock with a stable building) is used for keeping and grazing horses and for some cultivation - I assume that there will be no problem with that continuing.

I would be firmly against the proposal of the same land as a housing site, but this seems unlikely.

My only other observation is that it would have been polite and in the spirit of community for those nominating this area to have had the courtesy to inform those of us involved of their plan to do so. That, however, is probably not your responsibility.
