Stoke Gifford Parkway Station Area – Review of waiting restrictions Phase 3

Background

Following the council's recent review of commuter parking problems in the Parkway Station area and the implementation of waiting restrictions, additional locations were identified for a phase two review.

Further concerns regarding commuter parking problems were received from residents of the New Road, Swallows Court, Brins Close and Beaufort Crescent. A further request was received from residents of Terris Court to be included within the existing permit scheme in Church Road; these roads have been taken into account and included in this review.

The council has now included a scheme to carry out the second phase of the review of waiting restrictions in the Parkway Station area in the Capital Programme. Residents of New Road, Swallows Court and Brins Close, these three areas have been surveyed and achieved the trigger point of 70% support for area wide waiting restrictions and are being progressed under the previous permit parking requirements.

Discussions and site meetings have taken place between April 2013 and July 2014 with local councillors and local residents to identify where and what type of waiting restrictions should be considered.

Purpose of Scheme

The main purpose of the scheme is to discourage all day parking by rail users and students in residential areas, particularly where this causes safety or access issues, whilst at the same time minimising the effect of waiting restrictions on residents.

Proposed Scheme

The proposals include:

New Road & Swallows Court - indicated on drawing No. T429-545-004B

- No waiting at any time (Double yellow lines) restrictions on New Road for its entire length adjacent to the educational establishments,
- School Keep Clear restrictions at various locations on New Road.
- Permit parking Monday to Saturday, 11am to noon and 2pm to 3pm, in the residential areas at the northern end of New Road and Swallows Court.

Brins Close - indicated on drawing No. T429-545-005G

- Restricted Parking Zone, No waiting by any vehicle during the following times - Monday to Saturday, 1pm to 2pm.

Beaufort Crescent - indicated on drawing No. T429-545-005F

- One length of No waiting at any time (Double yellow lines) and one length of Limited Waiting, Monday to Friday, 1pm to 2pm. in Beaufort Crescent adjacent to number 22.

John St Quinton Close - indicated on drawing No. T429-545-006A

- No waiting at any time restrictions (Double yellow lines) adjacent to numbers 3 and 15.

Church Road – indicated on drawing No. T429-545-007B

- Properties within Terris Court to be included within the existing permit scheme, and eligible to apply for permits.
