




- New south bound bus lane (between Gipsy Patch Lane and Sandringham Road roundabout).

Summary of proposals:


- New bus lanes.
- MetroBus priority on Hatchet Road roundabout.
- Paths widened (from rail bridge to Bush Avenue and Gifford Crescent).
- Redesigned railway bridge.
- Two existing bus stops upgraded to MetroBus stops.
- Replacement of trees and vegetation.





ZONE 3 and 4 proposal East Works, North Way and the Cribbs Patchway New Neighbourhood

Zone 3 summary:

- MetroBus to run through the East Works Site.
- Direct access to new employment within the redeveloped East Works site.
- Short bus link on third party land required to link North Way to the East Works site.

Zone 4 summary:

- Crossing the A38 through the existing underpass.
- Through the Cribbs Patchway New Neighbourhood.
- Short new bus link on third party land near San Andreas roundabout.
