



Statement of Reasons

Charfield – Charfield Primary School - Proposed part time advisory 20mph speed limit

Background

South Gloucestershire Council made a resolution in September 2013 to ensure that, as far as practicable, all schools in South Gloucestershire are covered by a 20mph speed limit. This approach is in line with guidance from the Government, which is encouraging local authorities to introduce 20mph speed limits or zones in residential areas being used by people on foot or bicycle.

Purpose of the Scheme

The purpose of the scheme is to reduce traffic speeds in the vicinity of Charfield Primary School which will improve road safety for vulnerable road users as well as making walking and cycling to school more attractive.

Proposed Scheme

The proposed scheme is to introduce a part time advisory 20mph speed limit along Wotton Road (B4058) and Manor Lane.

We are proposing to install two advisory when lights show signs on Wotton Road and one sign and wig wag lighting unit on Manor Lane.

Timescale
