Please accept this email as my submission on the Inspector's Main Modifications to the South Gloucestershire Policies plan

I wish to register my opposition to the Cricket Ground at Abbots Road not being removed as a green space

It is my belief that when the adjacent greenbelt was decided, the only reason that this green space was not included was because it was thought to be secure.

As the local village cricket field used by both the people of Hanham and certainly in the recent past by school children the status of this land should be secure.

The Hanham Community set up a "Folk Centre" for the benefit of the people of Hanham, not for a developer to grab. As such I think that this area together should be brought into the greenbelt. This has been requested in the past.

The local MP Chris Skidmore has publicly demonstrated his opposition by collecting over 1000 signatures opposing any development here and on greenbelt land opposite signatures that were collected over a short space of time prior to the election, I am sure that there could have been many, many more.

Please give your careful consideration to this piece of land, as far as I am concerned that should be in the ownership of the people Hanham

May I add in conclusion that as someone who is not dealing in council documents all the time, that it is very difficult to follow your complicated processes. I am sure that if things were made simpler many more people would respond.
