We as a parish council, Oldbury On Severn, are concerned that in the amendments to the PSP, Section 46, appendix 1, that with the removal of the "Delivery Objectives" in the Flooding Section, the Key issues need to be strengthened with "proposed actions" to meet those key "Issues" for the village protection.

We also note that with the removal of the "Delivery Objectives" from all section within the report there are key areas that need far more consideration, such as Transport, Housing and Environment. These all have an immediate and significant impact on the whole of the Oldbury On Severn Community.

The Council feels that Emergency Planning should be in force now. As, with a large number new houses, up to 3000, being built close by this will have an impact on these new developments and OOS. This will become even more pertinent when we link this to Community Safety, Benefit a Quality of life, as the infrastructure to and from the village will become even more stretched than currently seen.
