Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to;

- a) prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in **Beaufort Road, Brookside Drive, Foxe Road, Meadow Mead, Mount Close, Park Row, Prospect Close, Rectory Road, Robel Avenue, School Road, Thornhayes Close, Western Avenue, Winchcombe Road and Witney Mead**, Frampton Cotterell and
- b) revoke the County Council of Gloucestershire (Built up Areas) Order (No.2), 1937 order in so far as it relates to Rectory Lane in favour of the provisions specified in item a) above.
