SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (CHURCH LANE, RANGEWORTHY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 201(-)

S T A T E M E N T O F R E A S O N S

Background

Concerns have been raised about the difficulties caused by inconsiderate parking in Church Lane, Rangeworthy. Problems occur when people park across the school entrance, and across or opposite driveways making access to and from driveways difficult. At present the situation is managed informally with no waiting cones. The school have requested school entrance markings and waiting restrictions that can be legally enforced.

Purpose of Scheme

The purpose of the scheme is to address obstructive and inconsiderate parking outside the school entrance, across and opposite driveways.

Proposed Scheme

The proposed scheme is to introduce school entrance markings outside the school gate and double yellow lines to replace existing advisory keep clear markings and areas currently informally protected by no waiting cones.
