

Statement of Reasons

Frenchay Hospital Area Waiting Restriction Review Second Consultation

Background

Following the closure of Frenchay Hospital, requests from residents have been raised to review the waiting restrictions on the roads surrounding the former site.

The first consultation took place between 13th August to 3rd September 2018, and in light of the responses received the following roads will be removed from the proposals, and no amendments to the current restrictions will be made:

- Pearces Hill
- Cliff Court Drive
- The Common
- Churchside
- Church Road
- Westbourne Terrace
- Tuckett Lane
- Quarry Road
- Frenchay Hill
- Chapel Lane

Purpose of Scheme

The purpose of the scheme is to remove unnecessary waiting restrictions following the closure of Frenchay Hospital. The second consultation will focus on the following roads:

- Lynton Way
- Malmaims Drive
- The Newlands

Proposed Scheme

The proposed scheme is to revise the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of the old Frenchay Hospital. The following roads are affected by this scheme:

- Begbrook Park
- Belfields Lane
- Bristol Road
- Fenbrook Close
- Filton Road
- Frenchay Park Road
- Homestead Gardens
- Malmaims Drive
- Manor Place
- Marlborough Drive
- Old Gloucester Road
- The Newlands
- The Park
- Wellington Place
