(Various Roads, Rodway Ward, Soundwell and Emersons Green Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation No. 1) order 20[-]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:-

- 1) vary the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads, Rodway Ward, Soundwell and Emersons Green area) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2018 so as to amend the lengths of waiting restrictions in Chiphouse Road, Elmleigh Road and St. James Street, Mangotsfield;
- 2) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (The Chase Area - South Gloucestershire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as varied in so far as it relates to Oaklands Road; and
- 3) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (Fairlyn Drive, Kingswood) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2016 the provisions of which will be consolidated unchanged into the new order.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Downend Public Library, Buckingham Gardens, Downend, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours.
