**Rodway Ward – various roads - proposed waiting restrictions**

**Background**

Funding has been prioritised by The Chase Area Forum to review the current waiting restrictions in Rodway Ward.

Following meetings and site visits with the local Councillors, it is proposed to modify existing waiting restrictions and introduce new waiting restrictions which include:

- No waiting at any time
- Limited waiting

**Purpose of the scheme**

The purpose of this scheme is to restrict dangerous areas of parking, maintain visibility at accesses and junctions, whilst ensuring that there is adequate parking provision for residents and visitors accessing the local shops and businesses.

**Proposed scheme**

It is proposed to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) to cover junctions/accesses and areas where traffic parking can reduce visibility and impact safety, and where access to service vehicles such as refuse lorries is currently hampered due to indiscriminate parking. The proposals include the conversion of existing advisory white keep clear markings, to no waiting at any time restrictions.

It is also proposed to introduce areas of limited parking in certain areas, to prevent all day parking, and also to modify the time limit in some existing limited waiting bays to allow sufficient access to the local shops and businesses.
