

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, KINGS CHASE WARD)**  
**(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 201[-]**

**Details of the proposed changes**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- a) prohibit vehicles waiting at any time in lengths of Alma Road, Alma Road (spur leading to Alma Close), Barnwood Close, Blue Falcon Road, Boultons Lane, Boultons Road, Brook Road, Burnham Drive, Cennick Avenue, Chipperfield Drive, Church Road (Kingswood), Church Road (Staple Hill), Collingwood Avenue, Crown Road, Dawn Rise, Deanery Road, Deerhurst, Downend Road (Kingswood), Gilbert Road, Gladstone Street, Hilltop Gardens, Hilltop Road, Hill View, Holly Hill Road, Honey Hill Road, Hunters Drive, Kennington Avenue, Kingsholme Road, Lansdown Road, London Street, Mulberry Drive, Neville Road, New Cheltenham Road, Nympsfield, Park Road, Pool Road, Pound Road, Seymour Road, Shortwood View, Spring Hill, Stanton Close, Staynes Crescent, Sweets Close, Sweets Road and Worcester Road.
- b) prohibit vehicles waiting between 8 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in lengths of Kennington Avenue;
- c) amend the waiting restrictions in the lengths of Chase Road, St Stephens Road, Soundwell Road, Staynes Crescent, Syston Way, Tenniscourt Road, The Park, Wellington Road, Walnut Lane and Worcester Road;

Exemptions in the order permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of boarding or alighting; loading or unloading goods; delivering postal packets; maintenance of the road; supply of gas, water or electricity; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties; taking in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage; weddings or funerals and in accordance with the current provisions for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Staple Hill Library, The Square, Broad Street, Staple Hill during normal opening hours.
