

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, KINGS CHASE WARD) (PROTECTION OF SCHOOL ENTRANCES)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 201[-]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:-

- a) protect areas marked with school entrance markings in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 in the lengths of Brook Road, Crown Road and Mulberry Drive, Kingswood by prohibiting any vehicle stopping, and
- b) vary further the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads - Protection of School Entrances) (Prohibition of Stopping) (Consolidation) Order 2012 in favour of the measures in item a) above.

Exemptions in the order permit any vehicle to stop for the purpose of building or demolition works; removal of obstruction to traffic; maintenance of the road; supply of gas, water or electricity; the pursuance of statutory powers or duties and fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Staple Hill Library, The Square, Broad Street, Staple Hill during normal opening hours.
