SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, KINGS CHASE WARD) (PROTECTION OF SCHOOL ENTRANCES) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 201[-]

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

There are a number of advisory keep clear markings that need Traffic Regulation Orders to allow enforcement to take place.

Funding has been made available to investigate the current provision of waiting restrictions and implement additional measures that will improve traffic flow in the area.

Purpose of the Scheme

Implement new waiting restrictions and convert advisory keep clear markings to no waiting at any time markings to improve traffic flow and access in the area and improve visibility for vehicles and pedestrians.

Proposed Scheme

It is proposed to implement No Stopping restrictions (School keep Clear Zig Zags) at various locations adjacent to schools to allow enforcement to be carried out, at locations where traffic flow is restricted due to parked vehicles, which cause congestion and safety concerns.

The following roads are affected by this scheme:

Brook Road, Crown Road, and Mulberry Drive.
