

## **SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**

(Various Roads, Kings Chase Ward) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) Order 201[-]

### **Details of the proposed changes**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 32 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

- 1) provide, subject to specified exemptions, a further length of disabled persons' parking place in Park Road, Kingswood
- 2) revoke the South Gloucestershire Council (Kingswood Town Centre and Locality) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) Order 2002 as varied in so far as it relates to the disabled persons' parking places in Alma Road, New Cheltenham Road, Park Road and London Street, Kingswood. The provisions relating to Park Road and New Cheltenham Road will form part of the new order.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Kingswood Public Library, High Street, Kingswood, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours.
