



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, KINGS CHASE WARD) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES) ORDER 201[-]

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

Funding has been made available to investigate the current provision of waiting restrictions and implement additional measures that will improve traffic flow in the area.

There is an existing Designated Disabled Persons' Parking Place and a Designated Loading Place in the Kings Chase ward north of the High Street that need to be consolidated in a new Traffic Regulation Order and included with the consolidation of existing and new waiting restrictions to allow effective enforcement to take place.

Purpose of the Scheme

To consolidate existing Disabled Persons' Parking Places and Loading Only Places in relevant new Traffic Regulation Orders to allow more effective enforcement to take place.

Proposed Scheme

It is proposed to implement a Disabled Persons' Parking Place and a Loading Only place at various locations in Kings Chase north of the High Street to allow enforcement to be carried out at locations where parking is restricted due to parked vehicles obstructing these bays.

The following roads are affected by this scheme:

Alma Road, Church Road (Kingswood), London Street, New Cheltenham Road, Park Road, London Street.
