

## **SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**

(Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation and Variation) (Variation No. 14 - Civic Centre, Kingswood) Order 201[-]

Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 35(1) and (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to vary further the South Gloucestershire Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation and Variation) Order 1998 so as to introduce a short stay parking place at the Civic Centre, Kingswood. The car park will be subject to a 3 hour limit, non-return within 6 hours, Monday to Saturday (inclusive) that will apply to all vehicles using the car park including disabled persons' vehicles.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order. If you would like to see a copy of the draft order, a map, any orders to be varied/revoked and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, you may do so at the Kingswood One Stop Shop, Kingswood Civic Centre, Kingswood and at Kingswood Public Library, High Street, Kingswood, South Gloucestershire during normal opening hours.
