



Statement of Reasons

Olveston Elberton Road/The Street – Proposed amendments to existing waiting restrictions

Background

Following the successful introduction of waiting restrictions in the immediate vicinity of the primary school and Olveston village, some proposals to further improve the extents of some of the restrictions have been put forward by parents and parish councillors. A review of the restrictions was undertaken during 2018. It was concluded that some amendments to the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of the school would be appropriate.

Purpose of Scheme

To reduce inappropriate parking near the school, reduce local traffic congestion and improve pedestrian safety (particularly for school pupils).

Proposed Scheme

To reduce the extent of the at any time (double yellow line) waiting restrictions outside the layby north of the junction between Elberton Road and The Street.

To extend the existing at any time (double yellow line) restriction on The Street (to the east of its junction with Elberton Road) outside the property "Rock Ridge", to replace an existing advisory keep clear H-bar marking.

To introduce new waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) operational from 8.30am to 9.30am and from 3pm to 4pm Monday to Friday on:

1. East and west side of The Street from its junction with Elberton Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Vicarage Lane / Church Hill.
2. Between the existing double yellow lines on Elberton Lane outside the Old School House.

Timescale

Subject to the comments received at consultation and public advertisement, the proposals will be implemented during 2019.
