A38 Alveston Church – Proposed Bus Stop Improvements

I am writing to you as you may be affected by a traffic scheme in your area. Concerns have been raised by disabled users regarding the accessibility of the Alveston Church bus stops on the A38. Therefore South Gloucestershire Council are proposing to move the southbound bus stop 25m southwest and install bus boarders, and to raise the footway outside 3 Gloucester Road to improve accessibility of the crossing by removing the steps.
