SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL A4174 STATION ROAD, FILTON – PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

Funding has been allocated to develop attractive cycle routes along and in parallel to the A38. This Toucan Crossing scheme forms part of this overall project and will provide cyclists with an improved, formal crossing of the A4174. This crossing joins into work already installed on this safer parallel route.

The current existing crossing is rapidly approaching the end of its useful life, and will have to be replaced shortly, and the opportunity is being taken to provide an improved crossing for both pedestrians and cyclists.

Purpose of the Scheme

To provide an improved single stage controlled crossing for vulnerable road users.

Proposed Scheme

To construct a new Toucan crossing on A4174 Station Road Filton to provide a more direct link across Station Road to make a more viable alternative route. The new crossing will provide a single stage crossing of the A4174, Station Road.

Drawing Reference
